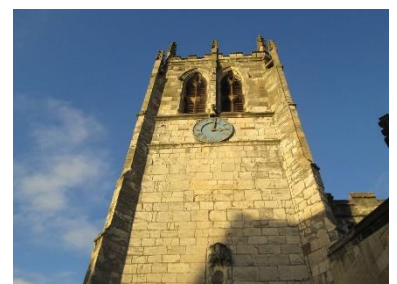

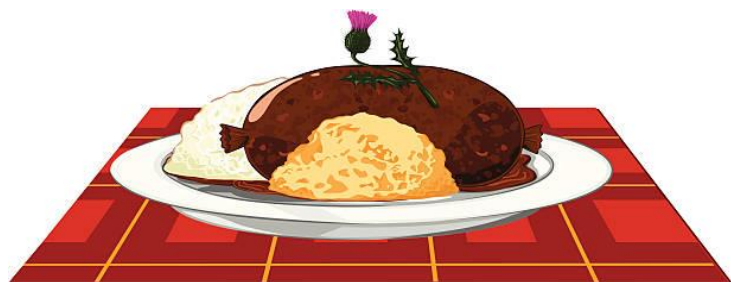


Benefice services
